Find us on the day - just follow the flags!

MORNING HORIZON | 9:45AM

📍 Various locations Town Centre

From East, South & West hillside locations, multiple performers play “morning calls into the valley”

Listen, look around and wander the town centre, a purposely fragmented experience.

MUSIC ON THE WIND | 10:30AM

📍 Packhorse Bridge, Bridgegate

“After some time, everyone descends in procession”

We'll meet-up together and be moving around town, sharing a gift of over 200 separate floating sounds.

ROYD'S ICES PIECE | 11:30AM

📍 Across the Town

“At this same moment a procession of 3 local ice cream vans depart HB train station to sell ice cream throughout the town.”

Listen out for 5 assorted sounds appearing from all over Hebden Bridge & Mytholm for 3 minutes.

TOY MUSIC | 12:15PM

📍 Calder Holmes Park, near Parklife Café

“Sitting in a circle near the ice cream vans, a musical improvisation was begun. Children who came to watch were given instruments and asked to join in”

Grab a coffee or lunch at the excellent Parklife Café.

MUSIC IN THE PARK | 2PM

📍 Memorial Garden, New Road

“The park in Hebden Bridge is intimate and peaceful, many people come to sit in the sun. Our musicians are placed in the park like further ornaments, merging in...”

AROMATIC BICYCLE MUSIC | 2PM

📍 HB Marina & Bridgegate

“Emerging from the town, in several directions, the group of cyclists converge on a number of locations, then invert their cycles and began to play...”

UNTITLED | 4PM

📍 Heptonstall & Mytholm, various locations

“Ringing of the church bells”

Something may appear overhead, somewhere.

A moment to pause and take stock, exploring the acoustic environment, between Mytholm and Heptonstall.

DISTANCE MUSIC | 10:30PM

📍 Calder Holmes Park, grass near skate-park and football pitch

“...for rockets, artificial incendiary and distant singers with loudspeaker system. To be performed after dark”
