

Home Remedies for Brown Recluse Spider Bites – For Instant Relief

Brown Recluse Spider bite can cause severe infection. These spiders do not attack usually but when it strikes then it can be dangerous. It is always necessary to implement the proper medication on the bite location as soon as possible. In case, if first aid is not helping in relieving symptoms of the bite and secondary aid (Proper antibiotics) is not available then home remedies can be helpful. Earlier treatment of the bite is always better. There are a lot of home remedies which can help in overcoming the symptoms of the Brown Recluse Spider bite.

We have listed some of the ***Home Remedies for Brown Recluse Spider Bites***. Do try them if no alternate recourse is instantly available.

Home Remedies for Brown Recluse Spider Bites

1. Poultices:

It is the mixture of different herbs, flour and bran etc. It is useful to overcome soreness and inflammation from the wound. It can be applied on the wound with the help of a cloth. A poultice can help in providing the relief from pain of wound for couple of hours. It is always required to apply fresh Poultices after 2 – 6 hours. For Brown Recluse Spider bite, the Poultices can be made with the combination of following materials:

| Material | Amount |
|---------------------------------------|---------------|
| activated Charcoal | 3 Tablespoons |
| Ground flax seed | 3 Tablespoons |
| Bentonite clay (or French Green clay) | 6 Tablespoons |
| Water | 1 Cup |



Method for Poultices formation and implementation:

- Mix all the ingredients in a plastic cup and then bowl it with a plastic spoon. Do not use any metal with clay.
- Make a mixture of all the material and arrange a piece of cloth.
- Tear the cloth into different pieces and put mixture on each piece of cloth. As, we have to replace the Poultices after regular interval that's why prepare a large amount of Poultices.
- Spread it over the wound and try to cover the whole swelling or red place of the wound with it.
- Cover the Poultices with the plastic wrap to keep the moisture in. Poultices will not work in dry conditions.
- Only use cohesive tape to attach it with the skin.
