

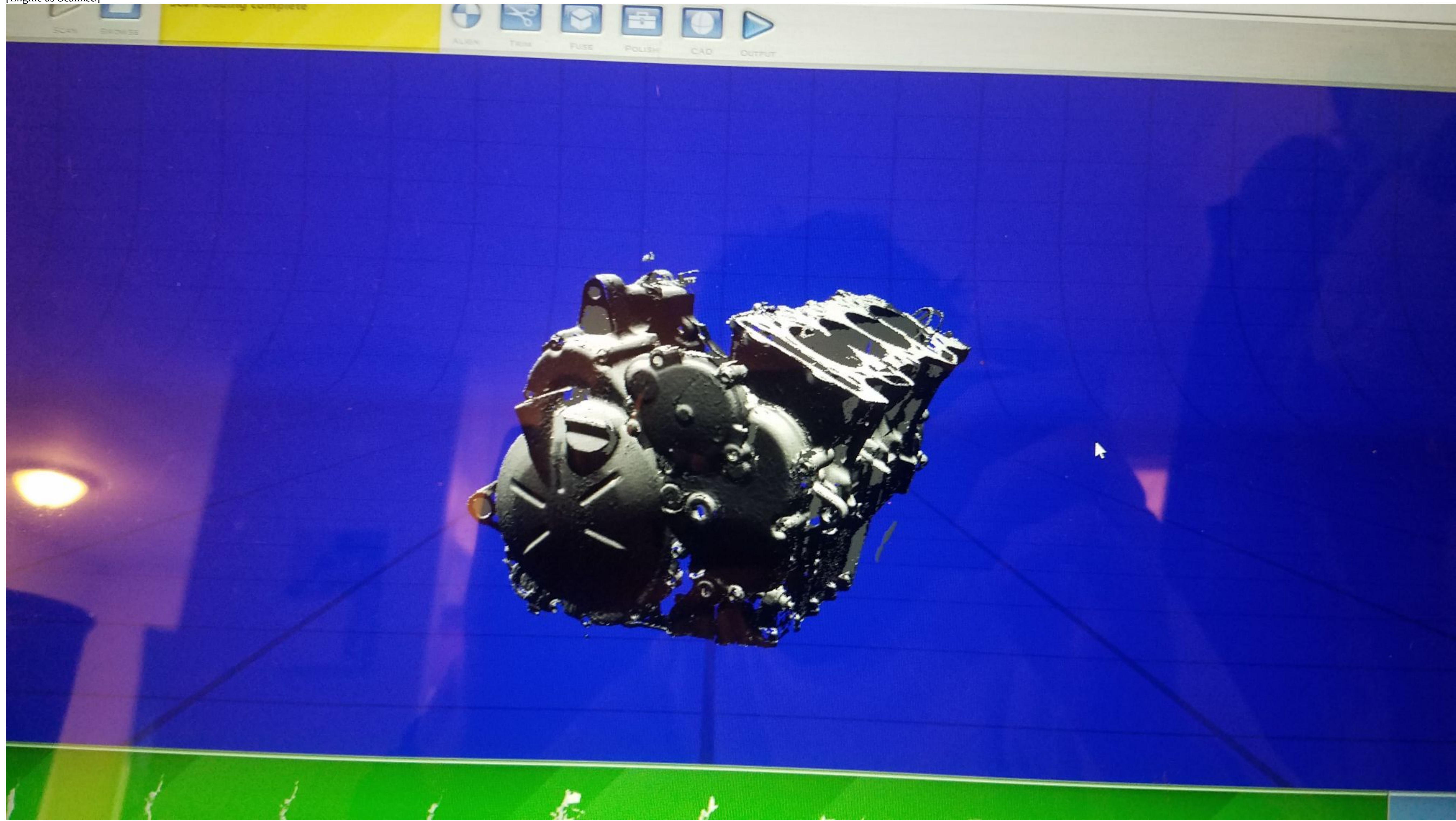
Re-cap of Zach "Friday notes"
